#### 3. Club Activities Updates

#### Membership Update (Paul)

#### **Members Page** (Kat)

- Finalizing the update of the members page although a few documents are unavailable.
- Useful information includes board minutes, club meeting presentations, Longboat Connect sessions, Awards Gala and more ...
- Plan is to announce in the next club communication (maybe along with a new password).

#### **New Members Brunch (All)**

- Approaching the maximum number of 40 participants.
- Relay event now has 12 teams including 5 6 new members.
- More volunteers are needed to help with finish line activity.

- Prizes for the top three teams, top 3 men, top 3 women (including SL10K & CRS event).
- George to moderate a panel with our recent Boston Marathon finishers.

#### **Uniforms & Inventory** (Sadie)

- Link for the online store has been fixed and will be circulated after the meeting.
- Sadie to pick up articles from University Settlement for the New Members Brunch.
- Suggestion for a triathlon uniform will be directed to the Strategic Planning group.

#### Club Runs (Steve)

- Attendance slowly increasing with a few runs now having more than 10 runners.
- Steve to guide a run group along the first half Toronto marathon course on April 23.
- April 30 will be first monthly long run from the Leslie/Lakeshore Starbucks for members living in the east end. (George reaching out to encourage current / former members).
- Route will be a 30 min loop before meeting those who want to meet up later or run less.

### Tom Longboat Day (Jojo)

- Tom Longboat Day with the Six Nations Reserve is approaching on June 4.
- Club members have supported their community 3K, 5K, and 10K runs in the past.
- Jojo suggested we start promoting and consider logistics for a group to attend.
- Carpooling or a van / bus are options depending on the number of people going.
- Club can consider paying gas expenses as per past practices (representing the club).
- Plan is to distribute some of the remaining Island Run shirts as per past years.
- Jojo to contact First Nations to get more event details for a club communication.

#### **Longboat Connects (George)**

- Final event in the Longboat Connects series with Bruce Kidd on April 25th (Jojo chairing).
- Bruce to speak about the origins of Longboat, our connections to the Indigenous Community as well as reviewing his book "A Runner's Journey".
- Targeting at least 20 people to join the call ... note actual attendance was 23 people.

#### Island Run / Sunset Shuffle Planning (George)

- George / Kat have updated the Race Roster page and landing page for the Island Race with registration starting May 1.
- Also working together through a long Q&A in anticipation of potential questions.

- Entry will continue as block pricing: 0 300 is \$45, 300 600 is \$50, 600 99 is \$55 and 900 + is \$65 (a \$5 increase from the \$60 last year).
- Lilly will be helping Kat with communications given the past web / social media workload.
- George and Lilly will visit the island to plan the Sunset Shuffle event and course layout.
- Also considering a kid's event (e.g. 400m) around 645pm before the adult 6km event.

#### 4. Financials Update (Bill)

- Financial situation is stable with roughly \$50,000 in the bank.
- Bill to setup Race Roster donations directly to charity accounts similar to last year.

#### 5. Other Business (All)

- Paul raised we need to organize a spring members meeting (in lieu of the exec meeting).
- Consensus was to schedule for May 24th at Settlement House with as a hybrid meeting.
- Bert proposed that Bert, Steve and George organize a summer track series that can be presented at the upcoming members meeting.
- Events could include 1500, 800 and mile as well as shorter distance for young members.
