- Thanks to team captains for their efforts: Sadie, Susan, and Bob
- Agreement was to reimburse \$25 towards entry fee for representing Longboat

Tom Longboat Day (Bert)

- Ekiden relays 2023Estimated 15 members joined the Longboat Day run
- Good feedback from organizers appreciated our participation
- Front Runners may be interested next year if carpooling is available
- Drivers will be reimbursed for car expenses as agreed beforehand

Summer Track (Bert)

- Bert and George are organizing ...
- Bert to check with Henderson's Brewery for a social afterwards
- June 28 ... 400M (Kids) / 800M / 2000M
- July 12 ... 800M / 3000M
- July 26 ... 1500M / 5000M
- Aug 23 ... 1 HOUR ON THE TRACK
- Races will be at Ecole Secondaire Toronto Ouest (Forest Hill Collegiate as backup)

Club Runs (Steve)

- Modest upswing in members participating in club runs with recent changes (e.g. east end runs) but it's not dramatic yet.
- One challenge seems to be limited pace groups due to small turnout
- May need to reconsider our approach for High Park runs given limited participation and upcoming park changes.
- More people now involved in coaching with summer / fall season approaching
- Steve and Lily will be developing a generic plan in early July

Club Uniforms (Jojo)

- Jojo and Susan are working on revitalized club uniforms
- Jojo has met with a potential vendor based in Manitoba to review options
- Intent is to have an online store where the club places bulk orders but members pay the vendor directly ... will likely launch in the fall before the upcoming winter season
- Singlets will continue to be provided free to new members

Sunset Shuffle (Lily)

- Lilly joined the meeting to review Sunset Shuffle plans with the executive team
- Currently have 201 registrations for the 300 available 6km race slots
- Social media posts by Kat immediately trigger an increase in registrations
- Race budget was reviewed including financial contributions from sponsors

• Bib design that reflects major financial and non-financial support was reviewed

Island Run (George)

- Registrations are tracking ahead of 2019 and 2022
- Shirt prices have been received from 5 vendors so a decision will be made shortly
- Considering a 3rd charity partner called Toronto Council Fire Native Cultural Center
- Chafing dishes, stands and fuel were donated to a soup kitchen run by Center 55 (Island Run BBQ now being outsourced so we don't need and frees up locker space)
- Plan is to adopt the 2018 medal indigenous design with new ribbons for this year
- Stephanie Allen has been confirmed as the piper again for the kids race and other activities
- Labatt approached us to promote their Michelob Ultra brand prior to a Michelob Ultra night race in September. They offered promo jackets and Garmin products for giveaways but are not willing to make a donation to our partner charities. Early feedback from the race committee is that it's not a good fit with the Island Run or our indigenous roots the consensus among the executive team was similar.
