3. Club Activities Updates

Membership Update

- Total of 92 members split by Male 56 / Female 36
- General 42 / Student Senior Unwaged 31 / Family 19 with coaching at 20
- New members ... 15 (7 new members plus 8 spouse / family of members renewing with the 2023 family plan)

Club Activities Updates

Summer Track (Bert)

- Successful summer track on July 12 with 20+ participants plus kids for 800M / 3000M
- Henderson Brewery was a good venue so Bert suggested ordering pizza next time
- Next sessions will be July 26 for 1500M / 5000M and Aug 23 for "one hour on the track"
- Consensus to proceed with the annual club cross country on September 13 and Bert has volunteered to follow up on food arrangements

ParkRun & Social (Jojo)

- Susan Stone has proposed a ParkRun (Barton Trail) and club social at her Uxbridge Lake home on July 29th
- Consensus this may be a fun event for club members so Jojo will engage with Susan
- Transportation would be informal carpooling similar to the Longboat Run at Six Nations
- Jojo will be the point of contact for member questions

Club Uniforms (Jojo)

- Jojo gave an update on the progress for new club uniforms
- He and Susan continue to work with Baltic to explore different designs
- Stock looks good with a strong focus on the singlet quality and sizes seem true for both men and women
- Intent is to place a bulk order(s) during the year with members ordering directly from a new web store that is targeted for Autumn 2023
- Other apparel is also being organized (e.g., hoodies, buffs, shirts, jackets etc.)

Sunset Shuffle and Island Run (George)

- Event is sold out with 300 adults / 18 kids although may add more people offline
- Permit and insurance are set with the permit due from Stacey Babb (City of TO) shortly
- Surplus of \$600 is forecast with plans to use that money to buy versatile signage for Sunset Shuffle / Island Run
- Registration at 1,372 is well ahead of the 979 last year at this same time
- Roughly 700 for the 10K, 461 for the 5K, 105 for the kids 1K and 106 for the kids 1M
- Duty roster is on track including school volunteers secured by Daniel LeBlanc
- George is orchestrating speaking arrangements for Tarrant Cross (New Balance) at local schools with Steve and Daniel
- Jojo has designed event flyers (promo material / volunteer info) that are being printed
- Jojo showed the shirt design which has been approved in principle by the race committee including a new Toronto Ferry icon on the left chest
- All shirts, including kids shirts, will be long sleeve for simpler logistics and to offer the same design for all family participants
- We are using 2017 / 2018 medals with a new ribbon design as a sustainability initiative

4. Financials Update (Bill)

- Bill reviewed the financials for June 30 and noted a cash balance of \$108K which is roughly \$38K ahead of last year at this same time although there are still significant costs expected for both Sunset Shuffle and Island Race
- Purchase of (club supplied) ferry tickets is still to be determined currently there is a balance of \$251 which is likely about 20 tickets
- Low \$50.20 expenses shown for Sunset Shuffle likely means most costs are still outstanding at this point and would mostly be reflected in the July financials
- Sadie to provide Bill with a list of Ekiden runners so he can issue a total reimbursement cheque to Jojo who will in turn eTransfer to individual participants.

5. Other Business (All)

• Jojo has offered to donate a Bluetooth microphone to simplify the setup for out hybrid meetings and improve voice quality as per George's suggestion
